* From 15 June 2023 to 15 December 2023, the price of admission tickets to state-owned cultural institutes and sites increases by €1 in order to finance the protection and reconstruction of the cultural heritage, both public and private, damaged as a result of the floods that occurred from 1 May 2023 in the regions of Emilia Romagna, Le Marche and Tuscany (Decree Law no. 61 of 1 June 2023, as amended by Decree Law no. 105 of 10 August 2023).

INFORMATION REGARDING ACCESS FOR GROUPS WITH MANDATORY BOOKING

(PINACOTECA NAZIONALE DI BOLOGNA)

Access for groups (8-25 persons) only with mandatory booking with the App io Prenoto https://ioprenotoapp.com

The booking time refers to access to the Baroque section where the exhibition is currently set up. Groups must arrive at the museum 10 minutes in advance. The time allowed in the exhibition spaces (Baroque section) is 45 minutes. After this time, the room attendants may invite the groups to leave the section. Out of respect for everyone, the utmost punctuality is recommended.

The groups will then be able to visit the remaining sections of the museum.

Without a booking, access will not be possible. It is recommended that the slot be booked for the maximum capacity (25 people) so as to avoid other groups booking in the same time slot: payment both online and at the physical ticket office will in any case be made according to the actual number of participants in the visiting group.

The booking does not allow for preferential access to the ticket office.

Those in possession of the ticket purchased online can skip the line at the ticket office and go directly to the reception point on the ground floor.

No invoice or cumulative tickets will be issued.

On days with free admission, access for groups may be limited due to the limited capacity of the exhibition halls.

Please note that the use of a Whisper System (microphone and earphones) is required for accompanied groups.

REGULATIONS ON ACCESS AND USE

Guided tours are permitted for groups of up to 25 people.

With the exception of guide dogs, animals are not allowed in the museum.

It is mandatory to deposit umbrellas at the entrance.

Backpacks and bags must be deposited at the cloakroom on the ground floor.

Eating, drinking and smoking (including electronic cigarettes) are prohibited.

Photos may be taken for personal use only but without flashes, tripods and selfie-sticks.

Please turn off your mobile phone ringtone and speak in a low voice so as not to disturb other visitors.

In the event of a large number of visitors, access may be restricted.
